- Presentation of the Project " *Monitoring the prescription of diclofenac with the aim of optimisation of its safe use",* which is co-funded by the European Union
- Project's background, general and specific objectives, indicators that need to be achieved, target groups, final beneficiaries
- CInMED Annual reports on consumption of medicines with worried data about consumption of diclofenac systemic formulation. These data are of special concerns because of CInMED continuous efforts to rationalise prescribing of diclofenac. Namely CInMED, accordingly to competent authorities for medicines in EU countries took measures to minimise the risk of exposing serious cardiovascular adverse reactions in patients who are predisposed for such type of adverse reactions.
- Data on diclofenac consumption in Montenegro are presented with comparison to its consumption in surronding countries and EU countries.

- Thanks to this project CInMED as Project Coordinator, in collaboration with its Project partner is going to introduce warning messages in IS of PHC with ultimate goal to rationalise prescribing of diclofenac and improve public and individual health.
- The warning messages in IS of PHC will serve HCPs as reminder on key information on safety profile of diclofenac and necessary steps that need to be taken by their side to prescribe diclofenac in safe and effective way
- At the end of the workshop Ms Maja Stanković kindly asked HCPs to follow recommendations of CInMED which are scientifically and evidence based.

After presentatin druring discussion HCPs have had some questions, remarks and very useful suggestions for further improvements in their daily prescribing of diclofenac and other medicines.
